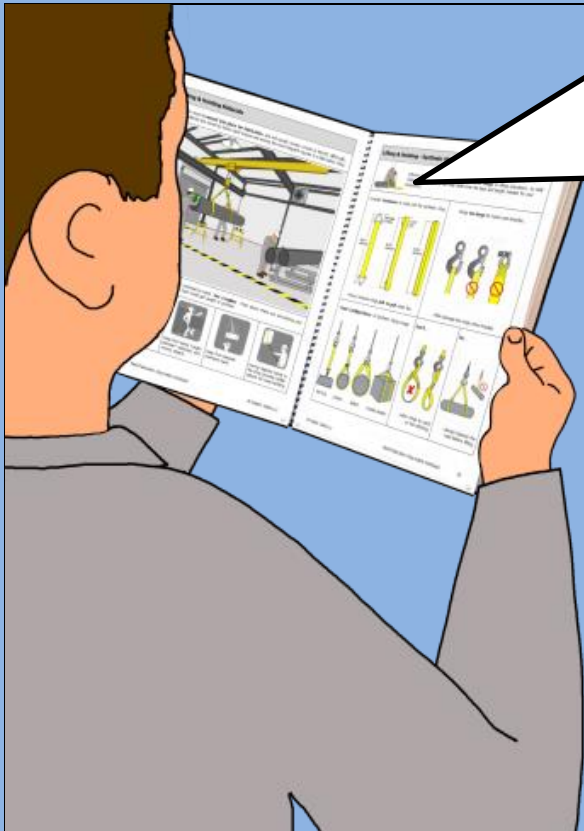




## Fun Read
